# Bond Street Station Upgrade Project

## ACTIVITY NOTIFICATION

Dear Sir / Madam,

This letter is to advise you of some forthcoming works for the Bond Street Station Upgrade.

### Moving the Hoarding

Due to the extended hoardings around 354-358 Oxford Street the footpath in Marylebone Lane will be closed. This closure will be in place until the project finishes in 2017.

The hoarding will be moved closer to the wall of the Radisson Hotel (highlighted in green on map below) and there will be a need to close the footpath in Marylebone Lane leading to Oxford Street. Access to Marylebone Lane is available via the entrance between the Radisson Hotel and Debenhams.

The extension in Oxford Street (highlighted in blue) is temporary and will be in place until June 2012, the width of the footpath will be reduced but pedestrians will have access to this area.

The planned move of the hoarding is due to begin on 20th February 2012, and is expected to take about two weeks to complete. The moving of the hoarding needs to be carried out at night, and we will of course keep the noise of the works to a minimum.



### About the Bond Street Station Upgrade Project

The Bond Street station upgrade will increase station capacity, provide step free access and deliver a new station entrance and ticket hall on Marylebone Lane. It is due to be completed in 2017, and will also provide access to the new high speed Crossrail services from 2018.
