



Borehole works on New Bond Street

As part of the works to build the new Crossrail Bond Street station eastern ticket hall, our contractor Costain Skanska Joint Venture (CSJV), will be drilling ten boreholes along New Bond Street. Once complete, the boreholes will house monitoring equipment to help us to protect buildings from possible effects of ground settlement during the tunnelling and excavation works for the station.

A drilling rig will be used to construct the boreholes which will be approximately 30m deep and 150mm wide. Once completed, ground monitoring instruments will be installed and a permanent metal cover will then be placed in the road allowing the hoarding to be removed from the site and reinstatement of the road.

The ten boreholes will be located on the eastern side of the carriageway in an area identified between 65 & 80 New Bond Street. Each borehole will be constructed one at a time along the length of the designated area in a phased programme of work.

The precise locations of the borehole compounds within the designated area will only be known once our engineers have carried out an investigation in the carriageway for obstructions using trial holes.

Due to the size of the compounds, this work will require a closure of two lanes, reducing the width of the carriageway to one lane of traffic on the western side. Access will be maintained to all the properties in the area.

These works in New Bond Street will commence from 13 February and will continue for approximately 8 weeks.

To maintain safety we will install hoarding around the site with fencing and use install acoustic barriers when appropriate to minimise noise. Our traffic marshals will be on hand to provide access for deliveries and assistance during normal working hours.

Where possible we will assist with special access/delivery needs and we encourage you to call us in advance of these works so that we can discuss any necessary arrangements.

Duration of work

- Borehole works will start on 13 February 2012 for 8 weeks.
- Weekday working hours: 08:00 until 18:00
- Saturday working hours: 08:00 until 13:00
- One hour start up and shut down periods are also permitted

What to expect

- Digging of trial holes to locate utility services
- Use of a drilling rig to construct the boreholes
- Traffic marshals on site to help with traffic and vehicle access
- Use of super silenced generator to control noise
- Use of fencing for safety

What we will do

- Ensure the footpaths around the site remain open at all times
- Ensure access to properties is maintained
- Operate security
- Monitor noise and dust and keep within permitted levels
