



Moorgate closures to facilitate large plant deliveries

On the weekends of Friday 24 to Monday 27 February 2012 and Friday 2 to Monday 5 March 2012 a full closure of Moorgate will be in place to allow for large plant deliveries to the Moorgate Shaft site. The closure will be introduced at 19:00 on the Friday and taken off at 05:00 Monday morning on both weekends.

During the evenings of Monday 27 February 2012 to Thursday 1 March 2012 Moorgate will be closed between the hours of 19:00 to 05:00.

Traffic will be subject to diversions that will be signed from the London Wall / Moorgate junction heading north and the Ropemaker Street / Moorgate junction heading south.

Moorgate will remain open to pedestrian traffic on the eastern footway only.

Moorgate is being closed to allow a large crane to be set up to lift various items of large plant from delivery vehicles into the Moorgate Shaft site. The crane will straddle the full width of the Moorgate carriageway requiring the existing covered way on the western side of Moorgate to be temporarily removed.

As the crane will take up the full carriageway width manual control of traffic on London Wall / Moorgate junction will be implemented in the form of traffic marshals to hold traffic while the delivery vehicles manoeuvre into position on Moorgate. These manual controls should last no longer than 90 seconds at a time approximately once every 90 minutes. The manual control will be necessary on Saturday 25 and Sunday 26 February 2012 only.

From reopening on Monday 27 February 2012, following the full weekend closure, Moorgate will be subject to single lane running northbound only. This restriction will remain in place until late May 2012.

Duration of work

- Friday 24 to Monday 27 February 2012 (19:00 to 05:00)
- Monday 27 February to Thursday 1 March 2012 evenings only (19:00 to 05:00)
- Friday 2 to Monday 5 March 2012 (19:00 to 05:00)

What to expect

- Moorgate Road closures between London Wall and Ropemaker Street
- Diversions in place for northbound and southbound traffic
- Pedestrian access restricted to Moorgate eastern footway only
- Manual control of traffic at London Wall / Moorgate Junction for 1 weekend
- Bus route changes
- Single lane northbound traffic on Moorgate from 27 February to late May 2012

What we will do

- Clearly sign all diversion routes
- Protect the public from the works with local fencing
- Maintain access to retail and business premises
- Keep disruption to a minimum

About Crossrail

Crossrail is the new high frequency, convenient and accessible railway for London and the South East.

When the service opens Crossrail trains will travel from Maidenhead and Heathrow in the west to Shenfield and Abbey Wood in the east via new twin tunnels under central London. It will link Heathrow Airport, the West End, the City of London and Canary Wharf.
