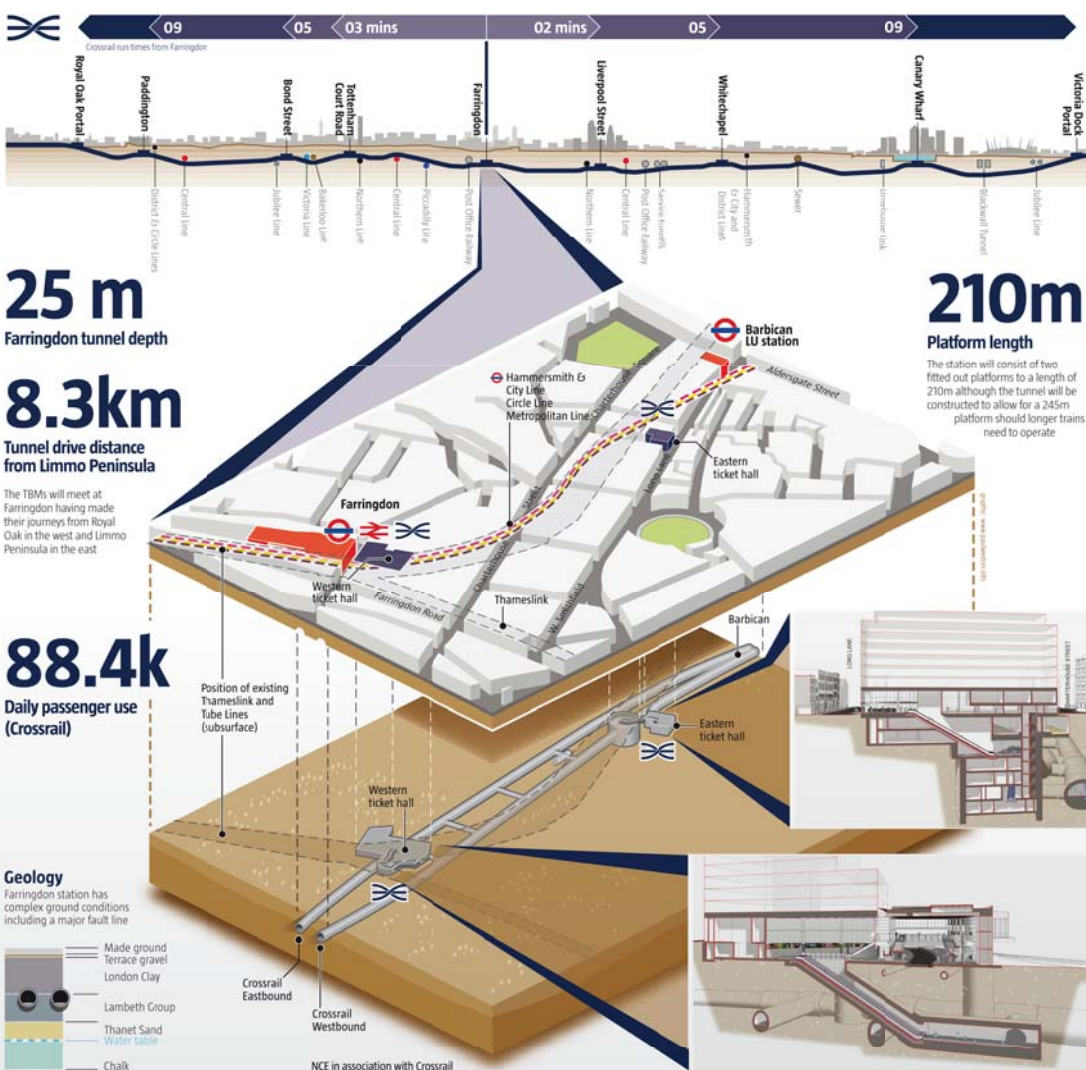


Farringdon Station



Key Facts

- By 2018 Farringdon will be at the heart of a new east-west and north-south axis
- 140 000 passengers a day will use the Farringdon interchange, one of the most important transport hubs in central London
- Linked to four of London's airports - Heathrow, Luton, City and Gatwick
- New integrated ticket hall with step free access to platforms
- Enhanced urban realm & new above-station developments.

Key dates

- 2010 – Demolition of Cardinal Tower, to make way for new Farringdon ticket hall to be completed in March
- 2010 – Demolition begins in East Farringdon (Barbican) mid-year
- 2014 – Running tunnel drives arrive at Farringdon from both directions
