

# Changes to buses at Moorgate and Liverpool Street

From Monday 27 February 2012



## CHANGES TO BUS ROUTES FROM MONDAY 27 FEBRUARY 2012

Work on the new Crossrail station is underway at Liverpool Street and Moorgate. Crossrail now need to close Moorgate southbound for the next stage of the work. Routes 21, 43, 76, 141, 214 and N76 will be diverted for about three months.

### Routes 21, 43 and 141

These routes will be diverted southbound only and will not serve Moorgate or Prince's Street.

Buses towards London Bridge will call at stop **S** in Chiswell Street and then run via Chiswell Street, Beech Street, Aldersgate Street, Cheapside and Poultry to Bank station, where they will serve stop **G** in King William Street.

Northbound buses towards Old Street will not be diverted and will continue to serve the temporary stop **B**, just north of Moorgate station.

This diversion is likely to change after about eight weeks, when the routes will serve stop **K** on Finsbury Pavement instead of the stop in Chiswell Street. Please look out for notices that will be posted in the bus stops around Moorgate.

### Route 214

This route will start and finish at Moorgate (Finsbury Square) and will not serve Liverpool Street bus station. The first stop will be **F** on the north side of Finsbury Square.

### Routes 76 and N76

These routes will be diverted southbound only between Moorgate (Finsbury Square) and St Paul's Churchyard. Buses will not serve Moorgate, Bank or Mansion House.

At Moorgate, the nearest alternative stop for buses towards Waterloo will be **S** on Chiswell Street.

Northbound buses towards Old Street will not be diverted and will continue to serve the temporary stop **B**, just north of Moorgate station.
