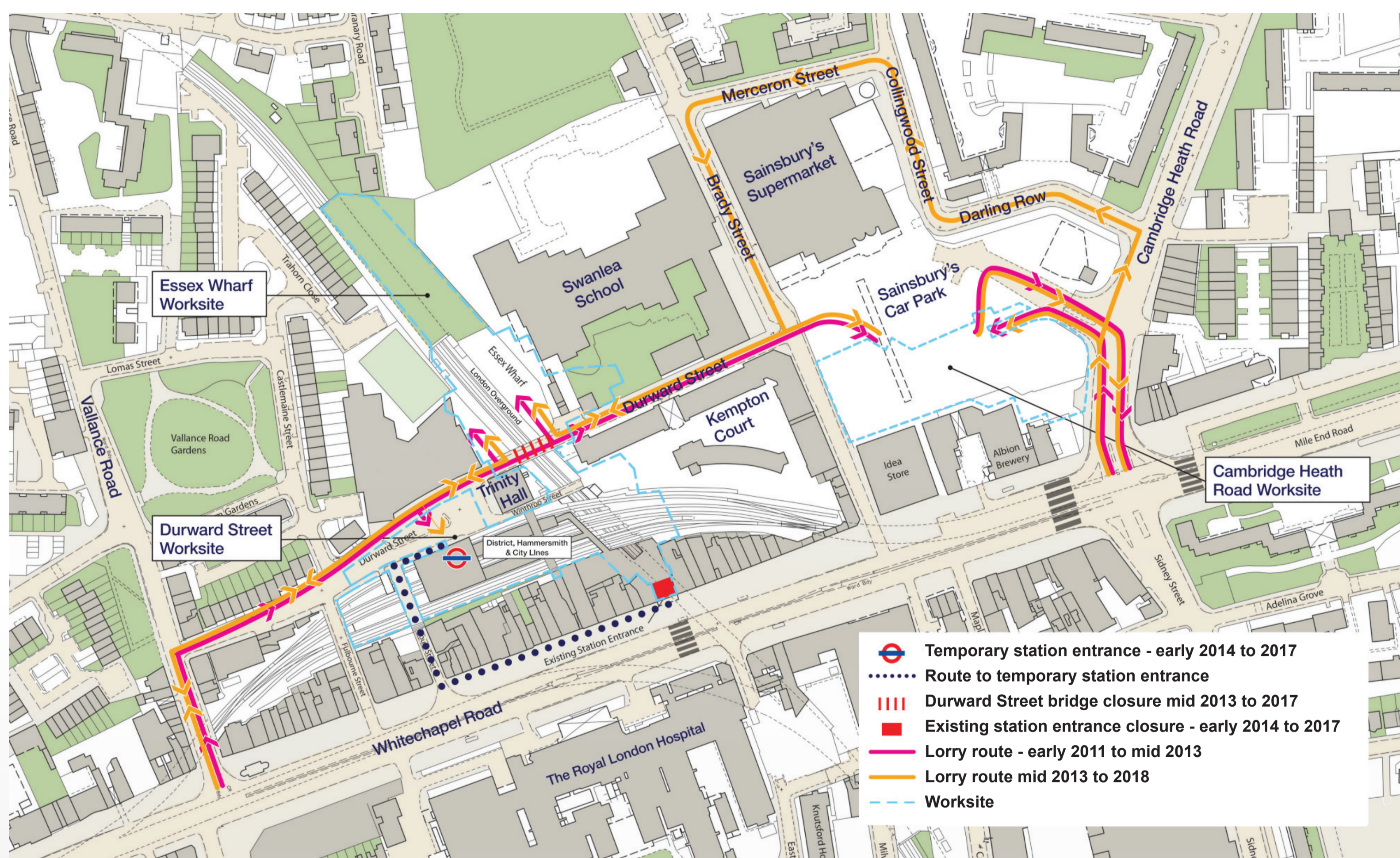


Construction Arrangements

Preparatory works are starting in the Whitechapel area this summer and main works start at the station in 2013, to be completed by 2018. During this period a number of roads in the area will be used by construction traffic and there will be some road and pedestrian diversions.



Pedestrian routes

During the construction of the new station, the existing entrance on Whitechapel Road will be closed and a new temporary entrance will be created on Durward Street. The route from the existing entrance will be along Whitechapel Road and Court Street, shown as the dotted dark blue line on the plan above. Local street improvements will be made where needed.

If other pedestrian diversion routes are necessary at different times during the construction programme, we will keep the community informed of each change and all diversions will be clearly sign posted.

Construction lorry routes

Crossrail's Construction Code, part of the Environmental Minimum Requirements means lorry routes are strictly controlled, and access to work sites will be via the routes agreed with the London Borough of Tower Hamlets.

Our agreed construction lorry routes are shown on the plan above.

- for the preparatory works, from June 2010, they will follow the pink route,
- from mid 2013 and to the completion of the works in 2018, they will follow the orange route.
